


# Why another church?

We thank God for the long history of gospel work in Parramatta. When we shared our plans to begin another gospel community in Parramatta, Bruce Morrison, Senior Minister at St. Johns Parramatta said "It's all about the kingdom."

Parramatta is the home of Australia's largest urban transformation project. New cultural and public spaces, commercial redevelopment, new transportation and multiple residential towers make Parramatta an exciting place to be. On top of that, the population is expected to more than double in the next 20 years.

And yet, our heart breaks that the most generous estimates are that only 7% of the Australian population have an active faith in Jesus. This same research revealed that more than half our population are open to changing their view.

That's why we're excited to come alongside other churches to see another gospel community in Sydney's Central City.

#### We will celebrate God's work in people's lives

# Why Parramatta?

Currently 36,000 people live in Parramatta (up 11,000 from the 2016 Census). In the next 20 years, it is predicted to grow up to 78,000. That's an increase of 115%!

With that population growth comes an urgency for gospel growth. More churches are needed to reach this city.

### A snapshot of people moving into Parramatta

A young family has recently migrated to Parramatta from India. He works as a labourer whilst She works shifts as an Administrative Assistant at Westmead Hospital. On Saturday mornings, you can expect to see Him at Parramatta Park playing cricket with friends whilst She shops at the Indian grocer down the road preparing for an extended family gathering happening the next day. The family would not consider themselves particularly religious although, they will partake in puja and visit the temple for special occasions.

A young professional couple recently moved into a new high-rise apartment tower that has views of Parramatta River. Her employer, the National Australia Bank, has moved into Parramatta Square so it's just a short walk to work. Parramatta is more affordable for them and there's the attractiveness of an urban lifestyle with plenty of public spaces, culture and nightlife. Deep down, they are longing for a community to be a part of. They wouldn't call themselves religious at all but they have an awareness of something bigger than themselves.

## Campus Pastor

#### Dan Lee

Dan was born in Sydney to parents who migrated from Hong Kong whereas Teresa migrated in 1988 from Singapore. Teresa accepted Jesus from a young age, while Dan came to know Jesus through an end of high school trip to the Whitsundays. Both met towards the end of university after significantly growing thanks to the Christian group.

After working in Human Resources and Science Administration respectively, Dan and Teresa both completed a Ministry Apprenticeship. Both went on to study at Moore Theological College (Teresa 1 year and Dan 4 years) before landing at MBM Rooty Hill where they have served for the last 9 years. During that time, Dan has been responsible for overseeing small groups, ministry teams (including the Ministry Apprenticeship program) and led the establishment of a new 4pm congregation.



Dan and Teresa have been married for over 16 years. God has blessed them with four children: Madeleine (12), Elijah (10), Alethea (7) and Evie (who sadly died after 77 days).

Since 2017, Dan and Teresa have both felt convicted and burdened to begin a Parramatta campus of MBM. They have been internally assessed by the MBM leadership team as well as rigorous external assessment by the Geneva Push network. They have a deep passion to see disciple-making disciples made, equipped and sent out for the sake of Jesus.

For fun, Dan loves anything sport-related, the odd geo-caching adventure and some day will finish reading one of his unfinished books. Teresa meanwhile is quite happy to stay indoors, watch Asian dramas and one day will finish her latest crocheting project. They both bond over ethnic food
